On June 7, 2017, the San Antonio River Authority hosted a Pre-Submittal conference to provide information and clarification for the Request for Qualifications for a Pre-Qualified List of Artist for the San Pedro Creek Culture Park. Below is a list of questions that were asked at the pre-submittal conference. SARA's official response to questions asked is as follows:

#### **QUESTIONS SUBMITTED AT THE PRE-SUBMITTAL CONFERENCE:**

Question 1: Does each section of the overall four phase plan have its own theme?

Response: Yes, the plan is for each phase to have its own artistic them. For more information about

the plan please see the San Pedro Creek Interpretive Plan, which is posted on

www.spcproject.org

Question 2: 20% of the Evaluation Criteria can be earned by the artist demonstrating sensitivity,

creativity and engagement with diverse communities. How can an artist demonstrate this

in the bid submittal?

Response: The artist can demonstrate this in their submittal with pictures, picture captions, resume

and the one page letter.

Question 3: Throughout the power point there was mention of both permanent and temporary art

pieces. Are artist allowed to submit only to one or both?

Response: The artist can submit only permanent pieces, only temporary pieces or both.

Question 4: Who will be evaluating the submitted proposals?

Response: The evaluation team has not been finalized at this time.

Question 5: How will we know if we made the list of pre-qualified artist?

Response: Artist will receive a letter letting them know that did or did not make the pre-qualified artist

list.

Question 6: Are there already current artist selected and if so, how were they selected?

Response: Some national artist have been awarded contracts to do large scale "anchor" pieces by

SARA's art consultant on the design team.

Question 7: Will the public have direct access to the art or will there be fencing or retaining walls

throughout the project?

Response: The design for the project consists of some railings in the high paseo and bridges at the

street level, but some areas will not have railings such as the low paseo.

Question 8: We would like to present several of our artists work for this project. We have three strong

candidates. Would you please advice on how best to submit the information? Should we

combine the artists' work in one proposal or send three separate RFQ's through

publicartist.org?

Response: It is suggested that the artists submit three individual bids, unless the three artist will

always be working together on each project.





#### Call Summary

The design of the San Pedro Creek Culture Park (Park) will radically change the current experience of the creek. In addition to providing enhanced flood control and revitalizing the natural habitat, the Park will also reconnect the community to the water through the creation of a world class linear park that reflects the unique culture of Bexar County. To that end, the San Antonio River Authority (SARA), working collaboratively with Bexar County and the City of San Antonio, seeks exceptional emerging and established public artists working in a variety of media and artistic approaches for its Pre-Qualified List of Artists (List).

#### **Budget Description**

The range of artwork budgets anticipated through construction of the San Pedro Creek Culture Park varies significantly with some projects estimated to be \$10,000 and others as high as \$1,000,000. Budgets must include all design fees; research and travel; models and renderings; fabrication, transportation, installation of artwork; site restoration, if necessary; insurance required by SARA and permitting; public programming and project documentation; and other project-related costs.
