Questions From Artists - City of Sugar Land, City Hall Atrium Public Art Project

Would you allow a collaborative application from an artist team where one artist is located in US and other artist is located in UK?

The eligibility requirements state that the project is available to artists located in the United States (US), therefore the US artist would need to be the sole applying artist. The contract would need to be held by the US artist, including insurance.

Can you provide interior photos of the building without the PDF embedding? *Please see additional Word document with images.*

Can you share the building's existing electrical system? Can you tell us if there will be three 20A circuits available in a panelboard in the building and provide a description of the location so we can estimate cost to run the needed circuits?

While electrical system drawings cannot be provided during the RFP period, we can gather this information if your design is selected for the project. Please keep this in mind as you estimate the project.

Does the city have an electrician that works on this building that we could contact for pricing on this work?

We do not have a recommended electrician.

Is there a utility room or electrical closet nearby where this could be installed out of sight of the public?

There are spaces that could be viable for this purpose. Keep in mind that staff will not be consistently available to manage a lighting system. Please be sure to discuss durability and maintenance of the artwork and the lighting system.

Does the building have any existing lighting control systems in place?

Simple light switches are utilized in this area.

Can you clarify the load bearing capacity of each mounting point?

Will the city entertain a project proposal that exceeds the \$82,200 budget listed in the RFP?

The budget for this project is not to exceed \$82,200.
