Based on difficulties artists have had in the past, here are some suggestions:

- 1. Upload each piece of art as its own "project" with the purchase price as the "budget"
- 2. In the description of the artwork, include the Title, Dimensions, and Purchase Price
- 3. Upload documents as PDFs
- 4. Use the PublicArtist guide for any additional help

How to put your best foot forward with image selection.

- 1. To assist with our judging process, we break up your portfolio into individual images and each image is assessed independently. As such we strongly recommend, where possible, that you **provide all images for the artwork/sculpture in one image**.
- 2. Please ensure that you caption each image with the correct price, dimensions, and title of the work.
- 3. The **quality of your image is everything**. A poor quality image will limit your chances of a successful application.
